Just a reminder....the recycling shed is located behind the Duchess Fire hall and is open 24 hours a day 7 days a week. We encourage everyone to recycling their paper, tins and cardboard.

Let's get the recycling out of our garbage.

Garbage pickup is on Tuesdays and starts at 8am

- 1. Garbage must be bagged and must fit in your bin with the lid closed.
- 2. Bins need to be placed with the arrows on the lid, pointed towards the street or avenue. Bins must be <u>at least 1metre</u> away from anything else as the arms on our truck require this much clearance.
- 3. Garbage placed on or beside the bin will not be picked up.
- 4. You are responsible for the storage of your garbage bin.
- 5. Please mark down the serial number on your rollout in case the bin goes missing and you need to locate it.
- 6. Replacement bins will have a replacement charge.
