The Village of Duchess Public Works Crew will once again be offering a week long Alley Cleanup event. This will run from May 22 - 25th and finish up on May 28th. Our crew will check the alleys every day and pick up items in batches... this means that they may leave some of your stuff behind for another day, but don't worry, they will come back for it. **A few guidelines for items...** Please keep your items to a reasonable amount... No Large household appliances - No dangerous items or items too heavy to lift - bundle branches and tie them together - if you have many things, please give us a call and book a time when you can help load your items. **PLEASE CLEARLY LABEL ITEMS THAT YOU WISH TO KEEP!** Otherwise we may assume anything left in the alley is intended for the landfill.

During the same week as the Alley Cleanup we are offering an area at the village of Duchess shop yard for e-waste and a paint Roundup. During this week, please bring tvs, computers, printers, etc along with cans of paint to the shop yard and we will have bins set up to collect these items.

The Duchess Parade of Garage sales is scheduled for May 25 & 26. An ad will go in the Brooks Bulletin and we will have an ad on the LED sign.

The Railway Avenue Paving project is slated for this summer. This repaving project will include highway 550 from highway 36 all the way through Duchess to highway 873. The project will also include the Duchess highway (873) all the way to Brooks. We are not sure what end they are starting at...but signage will keep us updated.

egg shells	non-decomposable items	underwear
Cleaning wipes	bandages	automotive fluids
pet poop	poisons and hazardous waste	
paint, solvents, sealants and thinners		hand towels/face cloths
