

Village of Duchess May 2018

Village Council has approved an increase to the 2018 tax mill rate:

Residential Rate – from 10.657 to **10.757**Non-residential Rate – from 13.657 to **13.957**

Some of our projects in 2017 were:

Margaret Avenue got a facelift with paving and curbs and sidewalks. We implemented a GIS system. We had an October Election.

The bulk water fill received a replacement cement pad.

We decommissioned the Rock Lake pump house.

Additional drainage measures were installed in Princess Park and around the Hall corner. Annual sewer line flushing and lift station maintenance.

We purchased a new-used Public works truck and an additional utility trailer. An Infrastructure plan was started, with a grant application to work with our neighbours Rosemary and Bassano.

Trailers....Please remember that trailers cannot be left on the street unhooked. A 72 hour time limit for trailers hooked to a vehicle is in effect and tickets will be issued for violations. Trailers may not be parked on your lawn. They must be in an obvious designated parking area. This means either a driveway or a gravel area on your property, designed for parking.

The alley cleanup will start on Tuesday May 22nd and run, weekdays, until Monday May 28th. Public Works employees will work their way through the Village all week and take items by category...so don't worry if they only take a portion of your items, they will come back for the rest. If you have any questions, call the office 378-4452. Please remember, it is not permissible to store garbage or other items in the alley other than during our cleanup week.

The walking trails around the Village have been very busy...Please remember that these trails are not for motorized vehicles.....and a reminder to pet owners: please pick up after your pet.
