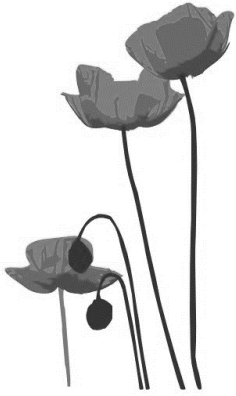


Village of Dutchess
